## Kindergarten Community Learning Plan

### Literacy Activities

1. **Watch** the video of Mrs. Ferrie reading the book “The Egg” on Seesaw.
2. **Read** the starfall book:



- a. Why do you think the chick is wet when it comes out of the egg?
  - b. What does the word ‘tend’ mean?
3. Read “**Hen**” on Starfall.com or the “Starfall Learn to Read” app
  4. **Hen Word Family** - Colour the picture of the hen from your learning package. (Use your best Kindergarten Colouring!!! 😊) Insert the letter strip and read the new words. Play our Word Family Song from SeeSaw. Jump up when the word you want to jump for is called.
  5. **Short E Game** - Play the ‘Short e cvc’ game with a sibling or parent. Make sure you read the word each time.
  6. **Hidden Egg Hunt** – Have a parent use the letter tiles to make some words to hide in the eggs. Then they can hide the eggs around the house for you to find. When you find the egg, open it up, unscramble the letters to create a word and read it to mom/dad or a sibling! Play again and again. If you want, you can also use the “Spell it/Write it” mat to spell these words on then print.

### Numeracy Activities

- **Ordering Numbers** – take the number cards and put them in order from 1 – 10. Do it backwards too. Have a sibling or parent take a card away and you have to figure out which one is missing.
- **Making Groups** – Put the number cards in a pile upside-down on the table. Pour out a pile of legos, noodles, little toys, etc. on the table. Then flip over a number card and make piles according to the number you flipped up. (Look at seesaw if you need to see what this should look like).
- **Shape Hunt** – Go around the house and find Triangles, Rectangles, Squares, Circles, Octagons, Hexagons. Take a picture of each shapes group you find and send it to Mrs. Ferrie.
- **“This is a \_\_\_\_\_” Game** – Take a shape and play this game with your family around the table. Check out seesaw for a video on what this should look like! Have fun and laugh!

**Bible:** This week we were going to start learning about Easter. Tell the Bible story about Jesus’ Triumphant Entry & Jesus Washing His Disciples Feet this week.

**Memory Work:** Luke 19:38a – Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord!
