Kindergarten Community Learning Plan

Literacy Activities

- **Watch** the video of Mrs. Ferrie introducing our new friend Mox the Fox!
 - **Read** the book “**Mox’s Shop**” & on Starfall.com or the “Starfall Learn to Read” app
 - **Feed the Fox Paper Bag Puppet** – colour and cut out the fox. Glue the head to the flap of the paper bag and the body on the bottom. Cut a hole for the mouth.
 - Feed “Mox” the letters of the alphabet.
 - **Feed “Mox” some words** (write words on the pieces of paper and feed them to Mox)
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- **Read** the book “**Pop! Pop! Pop!**” & on Starfall.com or the “Starfall Learn to Read” app
 - **Popcorn Hunt** – Parents, write some short “o” words on the yellow popcorns and cut them out. (see Seesaw)
 - **Option 1:** Pop a bowl of popcorn. Hide the “popcorn words” in the bowl. Pick one out, read it and feed it to Mox.
 - **Option 2:** Hide the popcorn words around the house (tape on walls, lay on floor, etc). Your child finds, reads and feeds it to Mox.
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- **Introduce TH** – listen to Mrs. Ferrie introduce the Th sound and read “The Thing That Went Thump”
 - **Do the Th Worksheets**
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- **Handwriting Heroes** – watch the Cannon Pops video on Youtube. Practice each of the cannon pop letters on the Spell It/Write it.
 - [Cannon Pop Video](#)
 - Spell some words that use cannon pops on your mat and then print them.

Numeracy Activities

- **Flip & Make** – Put the number cards in a pile upside-down on the table. Flip over a card, count out objects to match the numbers, then write that number 4 times on your Spell it/Write it mat.
- **Counting On** – Grab a game board that you have at your home (Candyland, Snakes and Ladders, etc) and two dice. Roll the two dice. Say the amount on one dice and then count on the next dice. Then move your player.
- **Shape Draw** – Have your parent call out a shape for you to draw on your “whiteboard” (cardstock in the page protector sleeve).
- **“This is a _____” Game** – Take a shape and play this game with your family around the table.
- Now give an attribute to pass around. Example: This is a “red triangle”



Bible: This week share the stories about The Last Supper, Jesus Washes Feet and Judas Betraying Jesus

Memory Work: **John 3:16** – For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.
