Kindergarten Community Learning Plan

Literacy Activities

- Watch the video of Mrs. Ferrie introducing our new friend Gus the Duck and introduce the concept of "upside down" with some short u words.
- Read the book "Gus the Duck" & on Starfall.com or the "Starfall Learn to Read" app.
 - Read some words upside down and see what tasks you can do upside down.
- Rhyming: While upside down or right-side up rhyme as many times with these words from the video:

Gus cut cup hug

- Swat Those Bugs! Colour and cut out the alphabet insects. Tape them up around the house/yard.
 - Use a fly swatter to swat the bugs in alphabetical order.
 - Write a word on your 'Spell it/Write it" mat and then swat the letter bugs that you wrote.

Insects

Watch the video with Mrs. Ferrie explaining what makes an insect different from just a bug.

Go on a bug hunt in your yard. Can you find any insects?

The Very Clumsy Click Beetle - listen to the story "The Very Clumsy Click Beetle" by Eric Carle.

Complete the activities as explained on the website.

<u>Plants</u> — Check your seed 2 times this week and record anything that happens in your Plant Journal. (This is the last week for our seed observation).
