Literacy Activities

 - **Send a video of your child reading at least one of the lists**

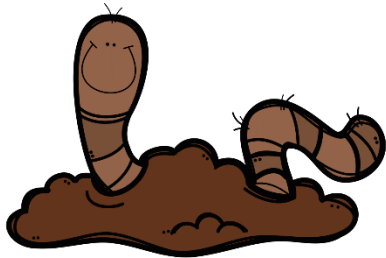
Dig, Dogs, Dig – listen to this story.

- **Shape Hunt** – Find 3 of each of the following shapes.

- **Sorting** – print off the sheet from the website. Sort according to these rules:
 - **Size**
 - **Shape**
 - **Number of sides**
 - **Colour/pattern**
- **Make Groups** – Flip over 2 number cards. Count out the amount of each card. Add them together then write the number on the Write it mat.
